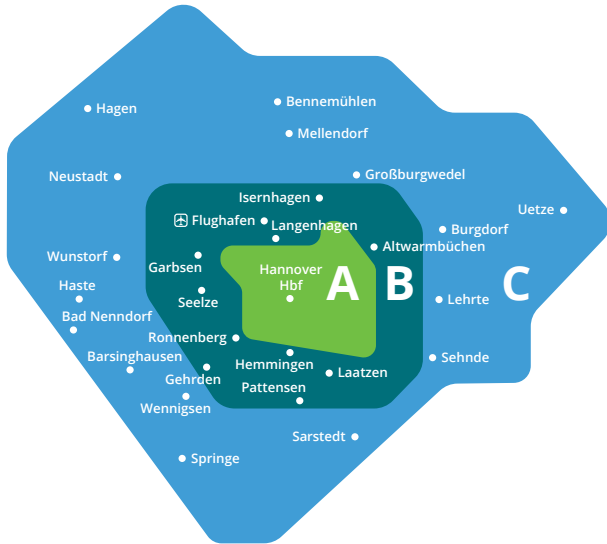

# GVH subsidised rate

In collaboration with the region of Hanover, GVH offers a subsidised rate for certain passengers. Eligible passengers who travel regularly with buses, trams and/or trains can use the **Monthly Ticket S** and the **D-Ticket (Hannover sozial)**. You can select the start of validity date for the **Monthly Ticket S** yourself. Once activated, the ticket is valid for one month.

The **D-Ticket (Hannover sozial)** is only available on a personal subscription basis. It can be cancelled monthly. The subscription ticket is always valid for one calendar month.

If you travel by bus, tram and/or train regularly but not every day, you can use the **Day Ticket S** at GVH's subsidised rate.

**Here's how it works:** Any **Region S Card** holder is entitled to the GVH subsidised rate. If you have not automatically received your **Region S Card** or have lost it, please contact the social welfare office (*Sozialamt*) in your town/city/municipality or the job centres in the Hanover region. This also applies if your benefit payments begin on a later date.



## Who gets a Region S Card?

**Region S Cards** are issued to people who live in the **Hanover region** and ...

- ▶ receive regular benefits (from the social welfare office) in accordance with Book XII of the German Social Code (SGB XII);
- ▶ receive regular benefits (from the job centre) in accordance with Book II of the German Social Code (SGB II);
- ▶ receive regular basic benefits (from the social welfare office) and benefits in special cases in accordance with the German Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (AsylbLG);
- ▶ receive regular additional social assistance (from the region of Hanover) and nursing support in accordance with the Federal War Victims Relief Act (BVG);
- ▶ live as a child, adolescent or young adult in a community of dependence and do not receive any benefits from the job centre due to their own income (recipients of the immediate supplement in accordance with section 72 (1), clause 2, no. 2, SGB II);
- ▶ live in a community of dependence and do not receive any benefits from the job centre or social welfare office due to own income (e.g. pension income).

If you have any questions, please contact your social welfare office or job centre.

## Day Ticket S

If you travel by bus, tram or train occasionally use the **Day Ticket S**. With the **Region S Card** as proof of eligibility, you can purchase a **Day Ticket S** for fare zone(s) A, B and/or C. This ticket is valid all day until 5 a.m. the following morning.

### Good to know

- ▶ Children under the age of 6 accompanied by an adult are entitled to travel free of charge on all buses, trams and trains within the GVH network.
- ▶ The **Day Ticket S Child** is available to children aged between 6 and 14 in the entire GVH network (zones A, B and C).
- ▶ GVH's subsidised rate is only available in conjunction with the **Region S Card** and official ID.

# Monthly Ticket S

If you travel by bus, tram and/or train regularly use the **Monthly Ticket S**. It is valid for one month in the travel zones you have selected. This ticket is non-transferable. For that reason, you are required to write your full name on the ticket.

The **D-Ticket (Hannover sozial)** subscription is also non-transferable. It is valid throughout Germany on 2nd class public transport.

### Good to know

- ▶ To use the **Monthly Ticket S** you need a **Region S Card** and an official ID. A verification check is performed during the subscription process to confirm eligibility for a **D-Ticket (Hannover sozial)**.
- ▶ The **Monthly Ticket S** entitles the holder to travel with one further adult and up to three children under the age of 18. It can be used Monday to Friday from 7 p.m. and all day long on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, as well as on 24 and 31 December. This is subject to all co-travellers being **Region S Card** holders and carrying their cards with them.
- ▶ If you want to travel further, you can extend your **Monthly Ticket S** with a **Day Ticket S** for one zone (A, B or C) or for the entire GVH network area (zones A, B and C).

### Available here

The **Day Ticket S** and **Monthly Ticket S** are available:

- ▶ From all GVH service and sales points
- ▶ From all ÜSTRA and railway company ticket vending machines
- ▶ In the GVH app
- ▶ From regiobus bus drivers
- ▶ Only **Day Ticket S** and **Day Ticket S Child** are available from ÜSTRA bus drivers.
- ▶ The **D-Ticket (Hannover sozial)** is available from gvh.de. You have to provide an own e-mail address so that GVH can load the digital ticket into the GVH app.
