



## FerienCard \*English Information\*

### How to take part on the FerienCard

#### 1 – Get your FerienCard

The FerienCard costs 12 euros; you can get it at many points of sale, such as all city libraries and citizens' offices. All locations are listed on our website. Children with a HannoverAktivPass receive the card free of charge.

#### 2 – Visit the Website

To book activities, go to [die-ferien-card-hannover.de](http://die-ferien-card-hannover.de) and select the activities you want. You can create your own wish list of up to 8 activities between May 20th and June 10th.

Please note: Family activities are registered separately; each family needs at least one FerienCard.

#### 3 – Enter your personal details

Confirm your selection and fill in all the required information. Have your FerienCard ready — you will use the code on it to register.

How can you register with your friends or cancel? See the "Questions and Answers" section at the end of the brochure.

#### 4 – Feedback

On June 19th you will learn by email which activities you can participate in and for which you are on the waiting list. You can cancel your activities, add new activities and pay for them using the link(s) in the email.

#### 5 – Instant Reservation

From June 24th you can reserve available places directly on our website. After booking, you will receive an email with the activity pass; you must pay within 24 hours.

#### 6 – Payment and Cancellation

Some participation fees are paid in advance online via PayPal or credit card, others on the day of the event at the event location... If you are unable to pay online, please contact the FerienCard office - we will find a solution! Cancellation information can be found in the "Questions and Answers" section at the end of the brochure.

Note: To search for events in specific neighborhoods or in categories such as "Sports", "Music", select the appropriate word from the "Category" field. Some events are marked as "external registration"; in this case you contact the organizer directly.

## Frequently Asked Questions about the FerienCard Hannover

1. Who can use the FerienCard?

Children and young people between the ages of 6 and 15. Family cards are also available.

2. When is the FerienCard valid?

Throughout the entire summer break.

3. Where can I get the card?

You can get it from the Hannover Tourist Information Center, citizens' offices, city libraries, leisure centers (Freizeitheim), cultural centers and swimming pools. The full list is on our website.

4. What are the program offers and how long do they last?

There are daily, weekly and hourly offers. From sports to creative activities and nature adventures, everyone can find something for themselves.

5. Do I have to register for the activities?

Some activities do not require registration; you can just show up spontaneously. There is no registration requirement for swimming pools and discount places, just show your FerienCard. For many other guided activities, you need to register in advance on the FerienCard portal.

6. How do I register and how are activity places allocated?

When you buy a FerienCard, you will receive a code. Together with your parents, create a list of the activities you would like to participate in at [die-ferien-card-hannover.de](http://die-ferien-card-hannover.de). On the specified date, the system will allocate places according to your application and send everyone a confirmation by e-mail. You can then add any remaining places online.

#### 7. What is an Activity Passport?

After the request list phase is over and after each new registration, you will receive a confirmation email. Here the status of the accepted activities and the waiting list is displayed; you can pay for the activities, cancel them or add them.

#### 8. What are the dates that I should pay attention to during the registration phases?

- The phase of the programs that require participation: Starts on May 20, ends on June 10.
- Direct booking of the last remaining places also starts on June 24.

#### 9. Can I register with friends or siblings?

Yes! In the second step, you can specify a "group password". All children who enter the same password are automatically linked together: either they all take a place or no one takes a place. Please pay attention to the case when entering!

#### 10. Can I get a discount with the HannoverAktivPass?

Yes, there are discounts for "AktivPass" holders on some activities. In the second step, enter your HAP number in the "Discount Code" field.

#### 11. How do I register for family activities?

Family offers are listed separately in the portal and require registration. The name of each participating family member must be specified and a valid FerienCard code must be available for each family member.

#### 12. How do I pay the participation fees?

Some activities charge a fee. The portal states whether payment is to be made online or at the event. PayPal and credit cards are accepted.

#### 13. What if I am unable to pay online?

You or your parents must contact the FerienCard office.

#### 14. What happens if I fall ill?

If you have not yet paid, you can cancel your activity pass at any time. If you have paid, you must contact the FerienCard office. Participation fees are only refunded with a doctor's report.

#### 15. Will I be refunded if an activity is cancelled?

In cases of cancellation due to low participation, illness of the instructor or bad weather conditions, the participation fees are fully refunded.

#### 16. Can I participate if I have a disability?

Participation in many activities is possible. You can find access information in the activity descriptions, and you can contact the FerienCard office or the Mittendrin e.V. Association at any time.

#### 17. Who organizes the activities? Am I safe?

The organizers are associations, unions, children and youth work institutions and cultural institutions. All organizers work with trained professionals and are checked by the FerienCard office.
