What does it mean?

A project of Lower Saxony Government with the aim of ensuring good medical care in the future, despite the demographic change in rural areas.







Implementation process

Gathering all kind of stakeholders around a table :

- Hospitals and universities
- Registered doctors
- Rehabilitation facilities
- Senior citizens and care facilities
- Self-help-groups
- Health insurances
- Medical chamber and Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians







Our common goals are

- We create structures that permanently enable needs-based medical and nursing care.
- We also find solutions where it is difficult to recruit medical staff.
- We want to set an example for other local authorities and set good standards (best practice).
- A project that sets an example here is the "development of holistic supply structures - on the way to a dementia-sensitive municipality based on the example of Burgwedel".







Starting position in Burgwedel

- Burgwedel has 21.2179 Inhabitants
- 1.384 People are over 80 years old
- The percentage of older people is very high
- The project involves affected people, relatives and the social environment







Goal of the project

- To find comprehensive solutions for the treatment and therapy of dementia patients.Ganzheitliche Versorgung stärken
- Develop supply management and individual case management and care strategies

Maintaining competences and self-determination







Ways to achieve the goal

- Networking of all involved
- binding arrangements
 - Establish support and accompanying culture
- Design of a life-oriented and tailor-made supply
- Networking of existing and initiation of new help and support systems
 Improving the awareness and sensibilisation of society for the topic dementia







Ways to achieve the goal

- Cooperation agreements between the supply areas are to be closed
- Public relations, information, qualification should be strengthened
- Experience based optimization should be done in the process







Effects of the project

- Benefit for sufferers and relatives
- Clear structure for health care and nursing professionals
 - Awareness of the public
- Establishment of regional supply management
 - Transferability to other regions
- Sustainability and strengthening of prevention







Results

- A networked supply and care chain that makes the questions of dementia transparently accessible should be created.
- An application for funding was submitted in August 2017 to the Ministry of Social Affairs of Lower Saxony.
- In November it became known that our project is one of two projects that will receive the highest grant of € 100,000. A total of 18 applications were submitted.
