## Tuberculosis (TBC):

- is a contagious disease that is caused by bacteria
- generally affects the lungs, but can also affect other organs
- can usually be treated well with medicines.
- The infection is spread by inhaling bacteria that are transmitted by coughing, speaking, sneezing of an infected person
- The following symptoms can be indicators: coughing, fever, fatigue, exhaustion, weight loss, night sweats
