

Dear parents,


Children enrich us: with experiences, affection and surprises. At the same time, the birth of a child fundamentally changes the life of the parents - and, not least, poses financial challenges.

In addition to the "traditional" family consisting of mother, father and child, other forms of living together with children are becoming more and more common: be it mothers and fathers who raise their children alone, parents who live together without marriage, or patchwork and rainbow families. Out of eight million families with minor children, about 19 percent are single parents. In the period from 1996 to 2018, the number of single parents rose from 1.3 million to 1.5 million. Of the 13.1 million children under 18, 18 percent now live with one parent in the household. As before, the vast majority of single parents, namely 90%, are female.

Single parents are not a uniform group: their living conditions and problems often vary greatly, but the risk of poverty for children in single-parent families is significantly higher, as is the case with children with three or more siblings or children with a migration background. The Coordination Office for Single Parents in the Hannover Region (*Koordinierungsstelle Alleinerziehende der Region Hannover*) supports and advises parents who are raising their children alone. The contact point established in 2011 as part of the federal programme "Networks of Effective Support for Single Parents" has been part of the "Early Help - Early Opportunities" Coordination Centre in the Hannover Region since 2013.

In this booklet, the Coordination Office for Single Parents and their cooperation partners have put together an overview of financial support available for families in the Hannover Region - from child benefit, support for parents with disabilities, BAFöG (Federal Training Assistance Act) benefits, all the way to child maintenance advance payments. In addition, parents can find all the important addresses and contact points in the cities and municipalities of the Hannover Region as well as information on eligibility and the application channels.

I am pleased to be able to provide you with this booklet, which will serve you as a guide to the diverse support offers and contact points in the region.

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A Arbeitslosengeld (SGB III) - unemployment benefit (SGB III)

Unemployment benefit (SGB III) is a benefit from the unemployment insurance scheme. It is regulated in the Third Book of the German Social Code (SGB III), in particular in Sections 136-162, 309-313 and 323-325. In official terms, the unemployment benefit (SGB III) counts alongside short-time work benefits, insolvency benefits and partial unemployment benefits as “benefit in lieu of income” and is therefore part of the promotion of employment. This support is given when a person becomes unemployed. If the person’s entitlement to unemployment benefit (SGB III) has expired, citizens' benefit can be paid.

The following persons are entitled to unemployment benefit (SGB III):

- employees who are unemployed. You fall under this category if you are not in employment or if you work less than 15 hours a week
- persons registered as unemployed with the Federal Employment Agency - this requires personal registration
- persons who have completed the qualifying period, i.e. in the last 2 years prior to registration, you must have worked for at least 12 months, for which you have paid unemployment insurance contributions. This means that “mini-jobbers” are also entitled under certain conditions (income of at least 520.01 per month).
- unemployed persons who have not yet reached the age of 65.

Requirements for the receipt of unemployment benefit (SGB III):

- you are entitled to unemployment benefits and have registered as unemployed
- you are making every reasonable effort to end your unemployment
- you are cooperating with the Employment Agency in its placement efforts, i.e. you are prepared to accept reasonable employment

Required documents: Please enquire with your local Employment Agency to find out what documents you need to submit as part of the application



Job Centre: Citizens' Benefit and More

If you do not have enough income to live, you can receive support from the Job Centre in Hanover.

The Job Centre also has lots of offers for parents. For example, the Job Centre can help you to find a job or apprenticeship if you have children. You can also receive help from the Job Centre if you encounter difficult situations, such as family problems or debt.

The Job Centre also secures your livelihood. You can receive citizens' benefit for this. This includes costs for everyday needs and rent. If you are pregnant or a single parent, you can receive more money. The Job Centre will also pay extra money for your child, for example for food at school and childcare, extra tuition or a sports club.

Leistungen nach dem Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz - benefits according to the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act (AsylbLG)

Among other things, the AsylbLG regulates special benefits for certain foreigners who do not (yet) have access to the benefit systems according to the Second or Twelfth Book of the German Social Code (citizens' benefit, SGB XII).

As a result, the following persons are entitled to these benefits:

- foreign nationals with a pending asylum procedure (Section 1 (1) No. 1 AsylbLG)
- persons granted a suspension of deportation (so-called "Duldung")
- persons in possession of certain residence permits (as specified in the Act)
- persons issued with an enforceable order to leave the country
- spouses, life partners or minor children of the above-mentioned beneficiaries.
- foreign nationals who submit a follow-up application or a secondary application in accordance with the Asylum

Act (Section 71 and Section 71a).

Another prerequisite, in particular, is so-called “material neediness”, i.e. insufficient income and assets.

Deciding whether you should be covered by the AsylbLG or other benefit laws is not always straightforward. It is therefore advisable to obtain clarification from the benefits authority, who will make the necessary enquiries with the immigration authority:

During the initial admission period, it is:

- the regional council responsible for your Initial Reception Centre

During temporary/follow-up accommodation:

- if you live in a city district: the city administration
- otherwise: the authority responsible for your place of residence (which is usually the Social Welfare Office)

Among other things, the AsylbLG provides the basis for the following benefits:

- allocation to work opportunities or integration measures
- provision for basic needs, such as food, accommodation, heating, clothing and health care
- benefits in the event of acute illness, pregnancy and childbirth
- benefits according to the education and participation package

The entitlement to the benefits usually ends:

- upon departure from the country, or
- at the end of the month in which the benefit condition ceases to apply.






B Bafög - Federal Training Assistance Act

A good education is the foundation for professional success. However, each form of education comes at a cost. No-one should have to give up on qualifications due to insufficient financial resources. The aim of the Bafög is therefore to give all young people the opportunity to complete educational training that corresponds to their skills and interests, regardless of their social and economic situation.

The Bafög is not only available for students pursuing a course of study at universities, but also for those attending other further educational institutions. Bafög benefits are available on the basis of a written application.

Berufsausbildungsbeihilfe - vocational training allowance (BAB)

The vocational training allowance (BAB) is granted during vocational training and during a pre-vocational training programme that prepares you for the secondary school qualification or an equivalent school qualification at an older age. Persons in vocational training receive the vocational training allowance if they do not live with their parents whilst in training. The vocational training allowance is granted upon application. The application must be submitted to the Employment Agency in the district in which the applicant is habitually resident. If an application for the vocational training allowance is submitted after the start of the vocational training or the pre-vocational training programme, it will be paid retrospectively from no earlier than the beginning of the month in which the application for the benefit is submitted.

Application documents: The application form is not available on the Internet. The applicant must submit the application in the responsible office.

Required documents:

- ID card
- a stamped copy of the training contract
- rental agreement
- proof of siblings (e.g. birth certificate)
- proof of parents' income

Befreiung von der Rundfunkgebühr - exemption from the TV and radio licence

As of 1 January 2013, one contribution is required per household. This means: one person pays the licence fee for a shared apartment, regardless of how many people live there and how many receivers there are.

You may be exempted from the licence fee or entitled to apply for a reduction in the licence fee for financial or health reasons. Please only send the documents listed. Please do NOT send any documents regarding the housing benefit, unemployment benefit I, care allowance according to care levels I, II or III of the statutory health insurance (SGB XI), etc. as part of your application. Proof of income, bank statements or your rental agreement are also not required.

To provide evidence that you meet the requirements for an exemption or reduction, you can submit:

- the original copy of the certificate from the authority granting benefits (e.g. "certificate for submission to the authority", "certificate for submission to the contribution service of ARD, ZDF and Deutschlandradio") of receipt of the social security benefit or of the award of the "RF" mark, or
- a certified (alternatively, original) copy of a current decision letter awarding you the social security benefit, or
- a certified (alternatively, original) copy of your disabled person's ID (front and back), or
- a current medical certificate or the original copy of an official certificate of deaf-blindness.

Required documents:

- a current certificate of receipt of the subsistence allowance in accordance with SGB XII or BVG (Federal War Victims Relief Act)
- a decision letter awarding you the social security benefit or citizens' benefit
- a current BAföG decision/certificate from the authority regarding the receipt of the benefits
- a current certificate from the authority regarding the receipt of the vocational training allowance (BAB)

Beistandschaft - legal advisership

In its capacity as the "legal adviser" of a child, it is the task of the youth welfare office to determine the paternity of a minor child and/or to assert their claims to child maintenance.

If it is impossible to determine paternity as part of an out-of-court procedure or if maintenance claims cannot be asserted as part of such a procedure, the youth welfare office will also act as the child's representative in court proceedings against the other parent.

Any parent who has sole custody of a minor child can

establish legal advisership at the youth welfare office responsible for their place of residence. If both parents share custody of the child, legal advisership can only be established by the parent in whose care the child is placed, i.e. with whom the child lives or who acts as the child's main carer.

A written declaration from the parent to the youth welfare office is sufficient to establish and terminate the legal advisership.

Legal advisership ends automatically if the parent no longer fulfils the legal requirements of Section 1713 of the German Civil Code, the child reaches the age of majority or relocates abroad.

The legal requirements for legal advisership are regulated in Sections 1712 et seq. of the German Civil Code.

Required documents: Please make an appointment with the youth welfare office responsible for your place of residence and enquire what documents you need to bring with you to establish legal advisership.

Bildungs- und Teilhabepaket - education and participation package

Education and participation in community life are key to achieving equal opportunities. The education and participation benefits support young people from low-income families to enable them to take advantage of school, nursery and leisure offers on an equal basis. Grants are possible in the following areas:

- excursions and trips organised by the school, nursery or daycare facility
- lunches at school, nursery or daycare facility
- school supplies
- school transport
- learning support
- contributions for courses, clubs and leisure activities



Young people are entitled to these grants if they or their families receive one of the following benefits:

- citizens' benefit
- social support (SGB XII)
- housing benefit and supplementary child benefit (Section 6b of the Federal Child Benefit Act (BKGG))
- asylum seekers' benefits (Sections 2 or 3 of the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act (AsylbLG))

If you are not in receipt of any of the aforementioned benefits but if you, nevertheless, have difficulty covering the costs of education and participation yourself, you may wish to have your individual entitlement to benefits from the education and participation package verified.

BKGG or AsylBLG

Elterngeld - parental allowance

Mothers and fathers are entitled to parental allowance if they meet the following prerequisites:

- you look after or raise your child yourself since their birth.
- you do not work more than 30 hours a week.
- you live in one household with your child.
- you have your place of residence or your habitual place of residence in Germany.

Required documents:

- application for parental allowance signed by both parents (with the exception of parents with sole custody of the child)
- original copy of the child's birth certificate
- certificate from the health insurance fund confirming the payment of maternity allowance
- certificate from the employer confirming that the post-birth maternity allowance has been subsidised
- income statement or payslips

ElterngeldPlus - parental allowance plus

Wishing to work part-time whilst in receipt of the parental allowance, and afterwards, is an advantage for mothers and fathers. With Parental Allowance Plus months, you can use the support provided by the parental allowance for twice as long, while you work part-time.

The Relationship Bonus is intended to help parents "join forces" to achieve a suitable balance of work and family. It enables parents to reduce their full-time employment to ensure that they can care for their children better. At the same time, they can work enough to secure the financial needs of the family. (Employment of more than a half-time position in hourly terms). The amount of parental allowance as part of a Relationship Bonus month is calculated in the same way as in a Parental Allowance Plus month.

For example, with Parental Allowance Plus months, single parents who have income from employment on a half-day basis, can continue to be there for their child longer than the 14th month of their child's life, whilst at the same time remaining competitive in the workplace. The Parental Allowance Plus and the Parental Allowance can be combined. Parents have a total of 14 months of the Parental Allowance in its previous form, which they can flexibly divide into Parental Allowance Plus months. For example, a mother can receive the full Parental Allowance for nine months, followed by six months of the Parental Allowance Plus. After the child is 14 months old, the parents are only entitled to the Parental Allowance Plus.

The contact persons for the Parental Allowance Plus are the employees of the office responsible for granting the Parental Allowance.



G Grundsicherung - basic subsistence income

The basic subsistence income for the elderly and for persons with reduced earning capacity according to the Social Security Code XII (Twelfth Book) replaces the subsistence allowance if either for reasons of age it can no longer be expected that the person will improve their material standing by taking up gainful employment, or this is permanently not possible for health reasons.

The following persons are entitled to the basic subsistence income for the elderly and for persons with reduced earning capacity:

- persons who have reached the statutory retirement age
- persons who have reached the age of 18 and who have permanent and full reduced earning capacity, provided that they are unable to adequately secure their necessary livelihood using their own resources, in particular, their income and assets.

As a rule, a full reduction in earning capacity is determined when the person's capacity is reduced due to illness or disability. This reduction must be so significant that, for the foreseeable future, the person will be unable to work for at least three hours a day under the normal conditions of the general labour market.

An application for the verification of eligibility must be submitted to the authority responsible for matters of social welfare in your place of residence.



K Kindergeld - child benefit

In principle, all children are entitled to child benefit from the month of birth up to the age of 18. Child benefit can also continue to be paid beyond the age of 18 under certain conditions.

You receive child benefit for all minor children who you care for on a regular basis and who live in your household. This also includes stepchildren, grandchildren or foster children. The prerequisite for your entitlement to child benefit is that you reside in Germany, another EU country, Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland or Switzerland. The child benefit is paid monthly by the Family Benefits Office to the person entitled to child benefit.

The law changed in 2018: in future, child benefit will only be paid retrospectively for the last six months before the month in which the application is submitted.

In future, the Federal Central Tax Office (BZSt) must immediately transmit data to the Family Benefits Office if it becomes aware that a child for whom child benefit is being paid has moved abroad or is officially de-registered by the Registration Office. In order to check the legality of the continued payment of the child benefit, the BZSt transmits the data specified in Section 139b (3) No. 1, 3, 5, 8 and 14 of the German Tax Code (AO) to the responsible Family Benefits Office.

- birth certificate from the hospital
- ID card
- parents' birth certificates
- marriage certificated or a certified copy from the Family Register

Single parents:

- ID card
- mother's birth certificate
- acknowledgement of paternity (if available)

K Kindergeldzuschlag - supplementary child benefit

Single parents and parent couples are entitled to child allowance for their unmarried children under 25 years of age who live in their household if:

- they are in receipt of the child benefit for these children
- the parents' monthly income reaches the minimum income limit
- the income and assets to be taken into account do not exceed the maximum income limit and the family's needs are covered by the payment of the supplementary child benefit and the family are therefore not entitled to citizens' benefit / social security benefit
- supplementary child benefit is determined under similar eligibility criteria as citizens' benefit

Required documents:

You will need the following evidence:

- rental agreement / proof of the liability for home ownership, proof of accommodation allowances (e.g. rent allowance or ownership liability allowance, in older cases - home ownership subsidy)
- proof of income from employment subject to compulsory insurance / marginal employment / self-employment
- proof of the cost of insurance
- proof of the cost of employment (income-related expenses)

Kostenübernahme des Elternbeitrags für Tagesbetreuung - payment of the parents' contribution for day care

If the parents cannot pay nursery fees or the fees for day care, these fees or contributions will be paid by the youth welfare agencies.

The applications for the payment of the parents' contributions can be obtained from the respective daycare facilities. You must submit your application to the responsible family service office or the youth welfare office in the municipality in which you live.

Please enquire with your local offices about possible changes to the current parental contributions and to find out what documents you need to submit as part of your application.

M Mutterschaftsgeld der gesetzlichen Krankenkasse - maternity allowance from the statutory health insurance fund

The maternity allowance is paid by the statutory health insurance funds during the protection periods before and after childbirth (normally 6 weeks before childbirth and 8 weeks after childbirth, or 12 weeks after childbirth in the case of premature or multiple births) and for the day of childbirth. An application for the maternity allowance can be submitted seven weeks before the estimated due date at the earliest, as the relevant medical certificate can only be issued one week before the start of the protection period. The maternity allowance of the statutory health insurance funds is only paid to women who are voluntarily or

compulsorily insured and who are entitled to sickness benefits. Voluntarily insured members who are self-employed on a full-time basis are only entitled to the maternity allowance if they have submitted a declaration of their entitlement to sickness benefits to their health insurance fund (option declaration).

Mutterschaftsgeld des Bundesversicherungsamtes - maternity allowance from the Federal Insurance Office

Employees who are not members of a statutory health insurance fund themselves (e.g. women with private health insurance or women with family insurance in a statutory health insurance fund) receive a maternity allowance totalling a maximum of 210 euro. In this case, the Federal Insurance Office (Maternity Allowance Office) is the responsible point of contact.

Child maintenance advance payments

The child maintenance advance payments are a benefit of the youth welfare office that serves to mitigate the complete loss of maintenance payments for minor children. The benefit serves to secure maintenance if a parent who is obliged to pay maintenance for their child does not pay it or is unable to do so. In this case, the responsible child maintenance advance payment office will make an advance payment to cover the outstanding payments. The child's maintenance claim is then usually transferred to the state in the amount of the maintenance advance paid. In these cases, the state then requires the parent obliged to pay maintenance to reimburse the disbursed cash benefits.

Procedure:

Child maintenance advance payment is a state benefit that a child receives if:

- their place of residence or habitual residence is in Germany,
- they live with a single parent,
- they do not receive maintenance from the other parent in an amount at least equal to the relevant minimum maintenance

The amount of the child maintenance advance payment is based on the minimum maintenance amounts set for the relevant age group minus child benefit for the first child.



S You can obtain further information from the responsible youth welfare office in your local authority:

Required documents: The single parent must visit the youth welfare office responsible for their place of residence in person and submit a written application.

The following documents are required for the application:

- valid ID card or passport with a registration certificate, also for the children (if available)
- residence permit
- the child's birth certificate
- acknowledgement of paternity
- proof of income tax class
- divorce decree, if applicable
- registration confirmation
- benefit decision letter from the Jobcenter, if applicable
- orphan's benefits decision letter, if applicable
- maintenance order

W Hannover and the surrounding municipalities) or if only one parent lives here, with the Hannover Region registered as their main place of residence, or if you attend a college, a vocational high school or an "Abendgymnasium" in the Hannover Region.

Exceptions: The BAföG office responsible for your place of permanent residence processes the application,

- if you are or have previously been married, or
- if your parents have passed away, or
- if the biological parents did not have legal custody of the child until the child's majority
- if the parents reside in different places (outside the Hannover Region).

Schüler-BAföG in der Region Hannover - student BAföG in the Hannover Region

Whether students are eligible for the BAföG depends not only on the type of school they attend, but - depending on the school type - also on other factors. With some types of school, a distinction is made according to whether attending the school requires previous qualifications. Whether the student lives with their parents or not, or whether a corresponding school can be reached from home can also be decisive for the possibility of funding. The Hannover Region is responsible for processing an application if both parents live and have their main place of residence in the Hannover Region (City of

Wohngeld - housing benefit

Households that live on a low income of their own should receive housing benefit to help them finance their housing costs. This can ensure that they do not have to rely on further social benefits.

Further information is available from the housing benefit office of your local authority:

Required documents:

- ID card / passport / for foreign nationals - passport with a valid residence permit
- registration certificate
- certificate from the landlord / rental agreement / letter of amendment to rent / utility bill / rental receipts
- income from capital assets (interest, etc.)
- all proof of income for all persons living in the household
- employment contract / training contract / wage slips / statement of earnings
- BAföG decision letter
- benefit decision letter from the Employment Office
- pension notices
- proof of sick pay
- proof of transitional allowance
- proof of maintenance
- income from renting and leasing
- certificate of study
- disabled person's ID, award notice from the Pension Office
- proof of care allowance
- in the case of divorced persons - the divorce decree if the applicant has custody of the child

Charity department stores

Charity department stores are department stores which mostly offer used and/or donated goods. They are intended to serve as an affordable option for purchasing consumer goods, household goods and textiles.

The staff are mostly made up of long-term unemployed persons, as it is often part of the concept of the charity department store to encourage these persons' reintegration into working life. In addition to the sale of products, charity department stores also offer services such as household clearance or goods transport.

The items on offer (large furniture, small furniture, household items, clothing, books, children's toys) are mostly used items in good condition.

Foundations

“Family in Need” Foundation

The Foundation primarily supports large families with at least three children entitled to child benefit, single parents and pregnant women who have their primary residence or habitual residence in Lower Saxony. To contact the Foundation, please first get in touch with an advice centre of the voluntary welfare service or your local youth, health or social welfare office. These offices will offer you assistance, support your application and forward it to the Foundation for processing.

“Mother and Child” Foundation Office

If you are pregnant and need financial help, please contact a pregnancy counselling centre in good time before the birth of your child. You can then apply for support from the funds of the Federal Foundation "Mother and Child - Protection of Unborn Life", which is awarded centrally in Lower Saxony by the “Family in Need” Foundation.

This support is intended, for example, to help you buy maternity clothes, baby equipment, set up a child's bedroom or move home.

Foundations and discounts of local authorities





State Capital of Hannover HannoverAktivPass

The City of Hannover introduced the “HannoverAktivPass” in 2009, which enables people with low incomes to participate in social life. The HannoverAktivPass entitles you to discounts at many institutions in Hannover, e.g. for admission tickets and/or participation/course fees in the areas of education, sport and culture.

All persons who reside in the Hannover urban area and who are in receipt of one of the following benefits receive the HannoverAktivPass:

- citizens' benefit or social security benefit (as a relative) from the Hannover Region JobCenter
- subsistence allowance or basic subsistence income (social support) from the Department of Social Welfare (or Senior Citizens) of the State Capital
- housing benefit from the Department of Social Welfare of the State Capital
- other ongoing social support (e.g. integration support,

care support) from the Department of Social Welfare of the State Capital of Hannover

- as an asylum seeker, benefits under the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act from the Department of Social Welfare of the State Capital
- supplementary subsistence allowance from the Hannover Region as part of the war victims' welfare scheme
